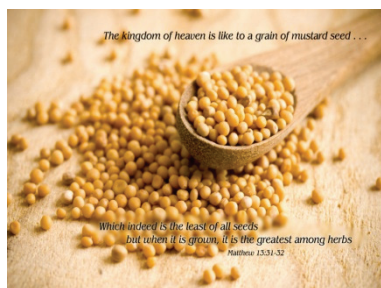

*The kingdom of heaven is like . . .
(Matthew 13:31, 33)*

In his parable of the weeds among the wheat, Jesus confirms what we already know to be true: evil exists in the world. We see evidence of it all around us. Sometimes it even seems as if evil is winning out. Will the weeds eventually choke out the wheat and overrun the field of God's kingdom?

Jesus assures us that it will not. In the end, the angels of God will sort the good from the bad, and evil will be destroyed forever (Matthew 13:41). The fact is, by his death and resurrection, Jesus has already won the victory over evil. Someday God's kingdom will reign over all the earth.

Meanwhile, how can we hasten its coming? It's significant that after telling the first parable about the weeds and the wheat, Jesus tells two more parables about the kingdom of heaven. It's like a tiny mustard seed that grows into a large bush (Matthew 13:31-32). It's like a little yeast that leavens a whole loaf of bread (13:33). These are hopeful images! God's kingdom isn't static. It begins in many small ways and then grows and grows.

You have a part to play in its growth! With every prayer, with every act of faith, with every good deed, you help to build the kingdom of heaven on earth. Making time for prayer, worshipping at Mass, helping the poor, sharing your faith, reaching out to a friend in need, speaking out in defense of life—in these ways and more, you can participate in growing God's kingdom. Yes, they can seem like small things. But so are the mustard seed and that little pinch of yeast.

So don't get discouraged by the evil you see, and don't give up hope. Believe that your small acts of faithfulness really do make a difference. And taken together with other believers, they become a mighty force in choking out the weeds of this world.

"Lord, may your kingdom come!"

Re-opening of the Church: All Saints' Parish

We are very happy to announce the re-opening of our church, in order to make our celebrations safe for all, here are some of the measures we will follow:

1. The City of Toronto by-law has made the wearing of masks or face coverings mandatory for all who attend Mass. Please ensure that you are wearing a mask or face covering each time you come to Church and that your face remains covered for the duration of the Mass.
2. When taking your seat, we kindly ask that you continue to select a place in the middle of the pew. This will allow other parishioner to fill in the end seats without disruption.
3. Communion at this time will be received on the hand only – not on the tongue. If you choose to wear gloves, please remove them before receiving communion.
4. When coming up to receive Communion, please exit your pew on your right as usual. Keep your face covering on as you wait on the markers. When you are next in line to receive communion, please remove your mask and approach Father. After Father says, “The body of Christ”, you respond “Amen”, receive and consume the host. You then place the mask back on your face and proceed to your seat.

We ask for the patience of those not wishing to receive communion to come and receive a blessing nonetheless. This is to avoid the unsafe practice of parishioners moving past each other.

On Monday, Wednesday and Friday, the Church will be open for prayers from 7:30am to 12:00pm. After that, the church will be closed to allow the disinfection for the next day.

All Saints Church has Capacity for 150 parishioners and we will work on a first come first serve basis for now. Please arrive at least 15 minutes before the Mass starts.

- For confessions please leave a message with your name and phone number to set up an appointment or send us an email.
- For Celebrations such as baptisms and weddings, we will start organizing schedules and appointment with capacity restrictions.
- Regarding funerals, please contact the Funeral Home and Father Andrzej Glaba and they will set up prayers and Mass times with you.
- When the office is closed to the public, please contact us by phone or email and we will get back to you as soon as possible.
- There will be no candles to light.
- We have placed all the Sunday Missals on a table, please feel free to take one and leave a small donation. That will be for your copy for the rest of the year.

Please notice we will not have Eucharistic Adoration during the summer. We will start again in September God’s permitting.
