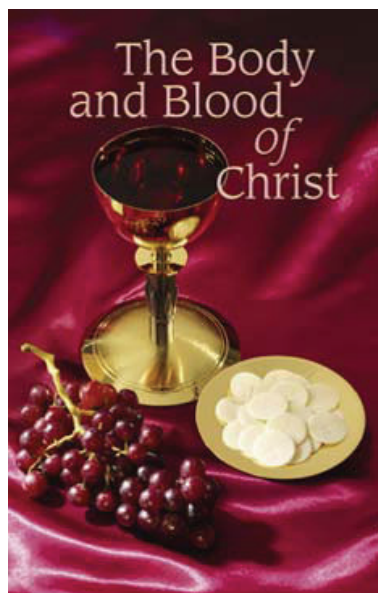

Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ Sunday June 6th, 2021

All that the Lord has said, we will heed and do. (Exodus 24:7)

When Moses splashed blood of sacrificed animals on the altar and then on the people, he was sealing a covenant between them and God. And just like any other sacred agreement,

something was required of both parties. For his part, God was promising to bless the Israelites and take them as his own "treasured possession" (Exodus 19:5). For their part, the people were promising to worship him and obey his commandments (24:7).

Centuries later, when Jesus shed his blood on the cross, he established a new covenant with us (Mark 14:24). For his part, he promised to cleanse us of sin "once for all" (Hebrews 9:12). He also poured out his Spirit, who would write his law on our hearts rather than on tablets of stone (8:10; Jeremiah 31:31-34). For our part, he asks us to follow his commandments, seek his forgiveness when we stray, and reflect his love and mercy to the people around us.

This means that you are not just a passive recipient of this precious covenant; rather, you have a part to play in upholding it. Of course, God doesn't expect you to do it on your own. He has given you his Holy Spirit and all the grace you need to be faithful to him.

Today is the feast of Corpus Christi. As you receive Jesus in Holy Communion today, take the opportunity to actively affirm the covenant God has made with you. Just as he renews his covenant with you every time you receive the Eucharist, you can renew your love and commitment to him. Tell him how grateful you are that he has bound himself to you in an unconditional, irrevocable bond of love. Then open your heart to his grace and let it strengthen your determination to love and serve him all the days of your life.

"Father, thank you for the covenant love you show me in the Eucharist."

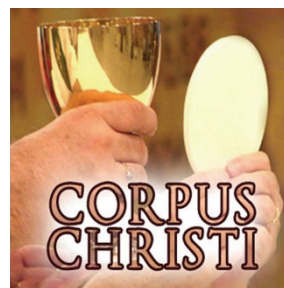

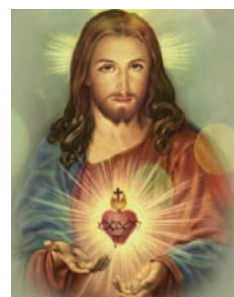
