**Solemnity** Ascension of the Lord May 29<sup>th</sup>, 2022

Stay in the city until you are clothed with power from on high. (Luke 24:49) Today we

rejoice that Jesus has physically ascended to heaven. What a sight that must have been for the disciples! The same Lord who had died and risen from the dead had now ascended before their eyes! But what would this mean for their mission? As they clung to his words, "Stay in the city until you are clothed with power from on high," they may have wondered how to follow Jesus now (Luke 24:49).

Luke tells us that the disciples "returned to Jerusalem with great joy, and they were continually in the Temple praising God" (24:52-53). So not only did they remain in the city, but they stayed together. It's easy to imagine the disciples returning to their homes in Galilee, but they didn't. They stayed and worshipped the Lord together. And that unity in prayer helped prepare them for the coming of the Spirit on Pentecost.

Like the disciples, we might wonder how to follow Jesus since he is no longer walking the earth. But the answer remains the same: Stay in the city. Stay close to your brothers and sisters in the Lord. When hard times come, we may feel distant from God or uncertain about what to do next. Confusion, hurt, or disillusionment can undermine our trust in the Lord and one another. In these situations, our first instinct is often to withdraw. We might avoid seeing people or even stop going to church. But Jesus encourages us: Stay in the city.

Jesus promises to give us the power we need to live as his people. He urges us, Stay close to your brothers and sisters. Stay close to me. Keep praying. I will fill you with my Spirit.

"Jesus, help me to stay close to you and to your people, even when I don't understand what you're doing." (Excerpt from The **WORD** Among Us)

The Lord said, "...you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth." Pray for an increase of vocations to the ordained and consecrated life. #### Requesting the Sacraments, Baptism Children (ages 4-7) First Communion & Confirmation:

### For 2022/2023 registrations opens May 1, 2022 and closes on August 30, 2022.

In order to deal with the backlog for our parishioners, we strongly recommend that:

- Parents of children who are candidates for First Communion/Reconciliation in Grades 3 and up and Confirmation in Grades 8 and up register their children in May 2022.
- Parents of children who are candidates for First Communion/Reconciliation and Confirmation who will be in Grade 2 or 7 in September 2022 register their children in June 2022 and July 2022.

This first step of registration requires that parents register their children by emailing the names of their children along with the Sacrament they are requesting to mbetro@archtoronto.org. **Registration closes August 30.**
